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Pronouncing the letter "h"

- the letter "h" is pronounced /eitch/, "ei" as in the Portuguese diphthong and "ch" as in "chão"

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"h"

- when in a word the letter "h" can be pronounced or not
 - when it's pronounced, the "h" appears in the sound: /hauss/ (house) and /hórss/ (horse); and it's pronounced as in "ha, ha, ha" (watch this [video clip](#))
 - when it's not pronounced, it doesn't appear: /auar/ (hour) and /ónasst/ (honest)
