### Webinars in 2016

All I need from you, the teacher, is a list of words that students have difficulty pronouncing. And I can add others.

I will also need to have the date and time that is best for your class. Finally, it would be very helpful to have a test session in advance with just the teacher.

Each Hangout on Air will be recorded so that I can make it available to others in my YouTube channel. You may need to get permission from parents for their children to be filmed.

Are there any volunteers? I hope so, because this will be a fun and interesting experience for all.
